**Tour 1:        Walking Tour - Rose Hill Cemetery – 229 East Liberty Street –  
                  Park at the cemetery**

Join Jan Ramsey and Mary Montgomery as they walk you through this historic cemetery. They will tell you about York citizens who helped shape our community.

**Tour 2:        Walking Tour – College and East Liberty Street Houses  
                  Tour starts and ends at the McCelvey Center –  
                  212 East Jefferson Street**

Gary and Paulajo Gross, East Liberty residents, will lead you as they walk through this historic neighborhood of College and East Liberty Streets. You will explore the different architecture styles such as Greek Revival, Gothic Revival, Tuscan Villa, Folk Victorian, Queen Anne, and Colonial Revival and learn about former owners and the stories associated with some of these beautiful homes.

**Tour 3:        Walking Tour - Olde Downtown York  
                  Tour starts and ends at the McCelvey Center –  
                  212 East Jefferson Street**

Russell Propst and Chloe Jones will lead you down Jefferson Street to visit the old Circus Winter Quarters. A few of the other places you will see are Rose's Hotel, the old Latta house, renovated York County Courthouse, and old jail on South Congress Street. You will learn about the Indian trails and militia paths that became streets and the location of the mule race track among other things. The tour will continue down East Liberty Street before turning on College to return to the McCelvey Center.
